







Evolution of rail, road and Combined Transport 1995-2005




Evolution of UIRR Combined Traffic




Part of Combined transport in % of tkm Road (>300km) and Rail 2005/6



UIRR International Combined Transport Flows




CO₂ reduction of Combined Transport
