# Reasons for training

- New employees
- Labour shortages
- Mitigate high turnover of staff
- Provide new knowledge and skills because of road sector changes
  Improve quality of work, raise staff calibre, prevent deterioration in performance

 Determine training priorities
 Complementary requirements (new technologies, new management systems)

Internal training
 External training
 On-the-job training
 Classroom training
 Out-of-country training

MSc training (classroom training, out-of-country training)
 Short courses (classroom training, external training, out-of-country training )

#### **MSc training**

MSc training: form and content of

- a typical course
- Taught elements
- Research elements
- Assessment
- Duration of studies
- Qualification obtained: University degree (postgraduate)
- Results: long-term and short-term

# **Short courses**

- Short courses: form and content of a typical course
  - Specific topic
  - Heavy involvement of the industry
  - No assessment
  - Day-courses week-long courses
- Qualification obtained: certificate (of attendance), CPD
- Results: short-term and long-term
