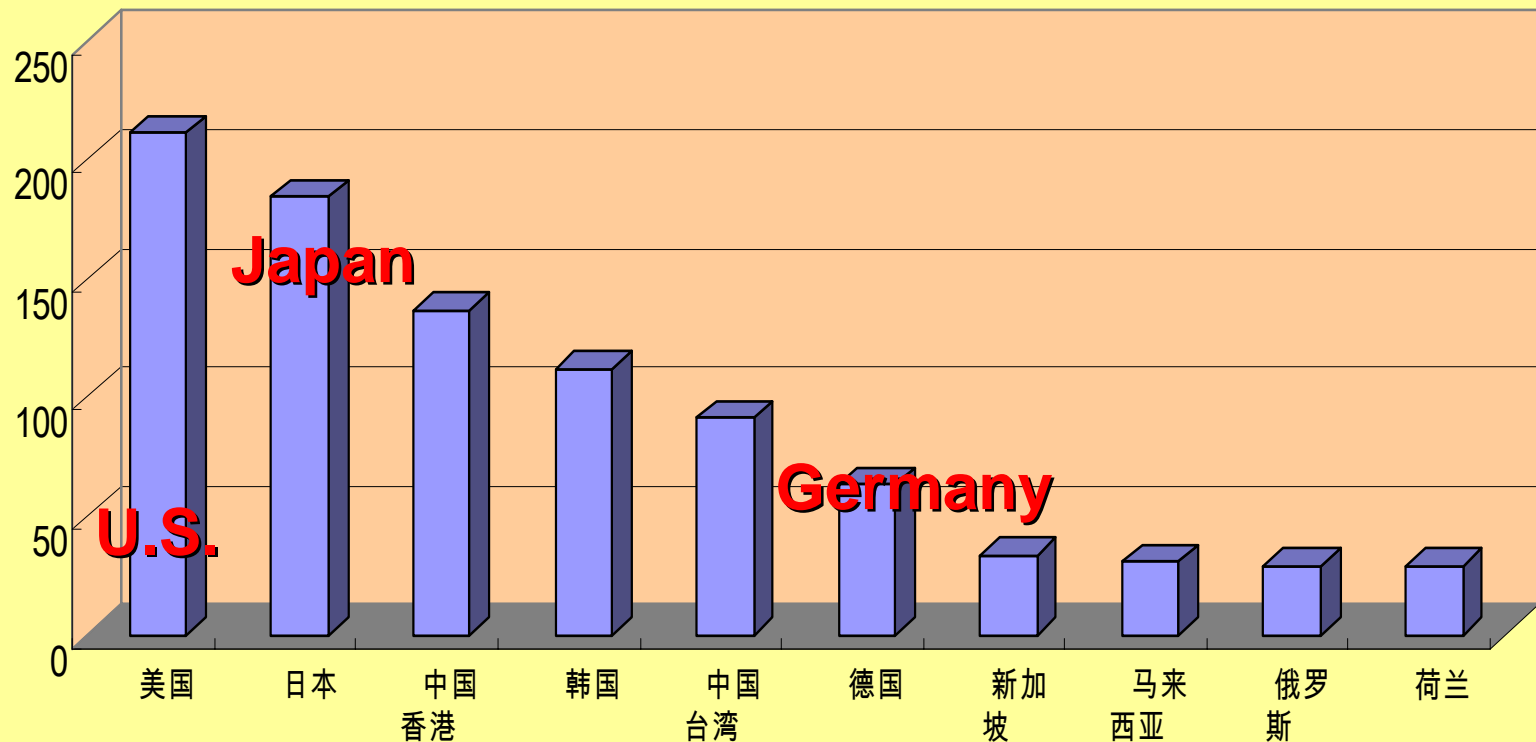

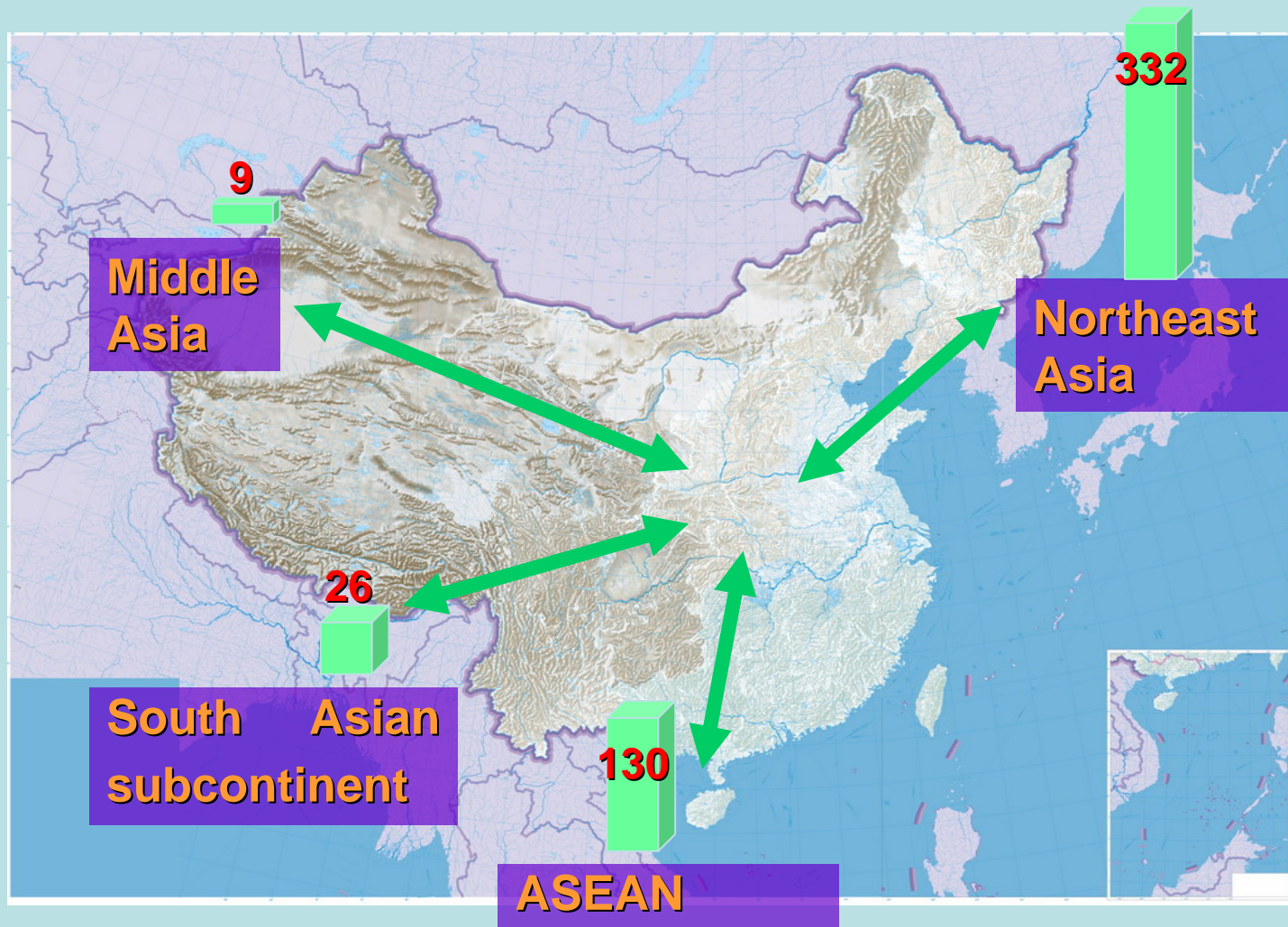

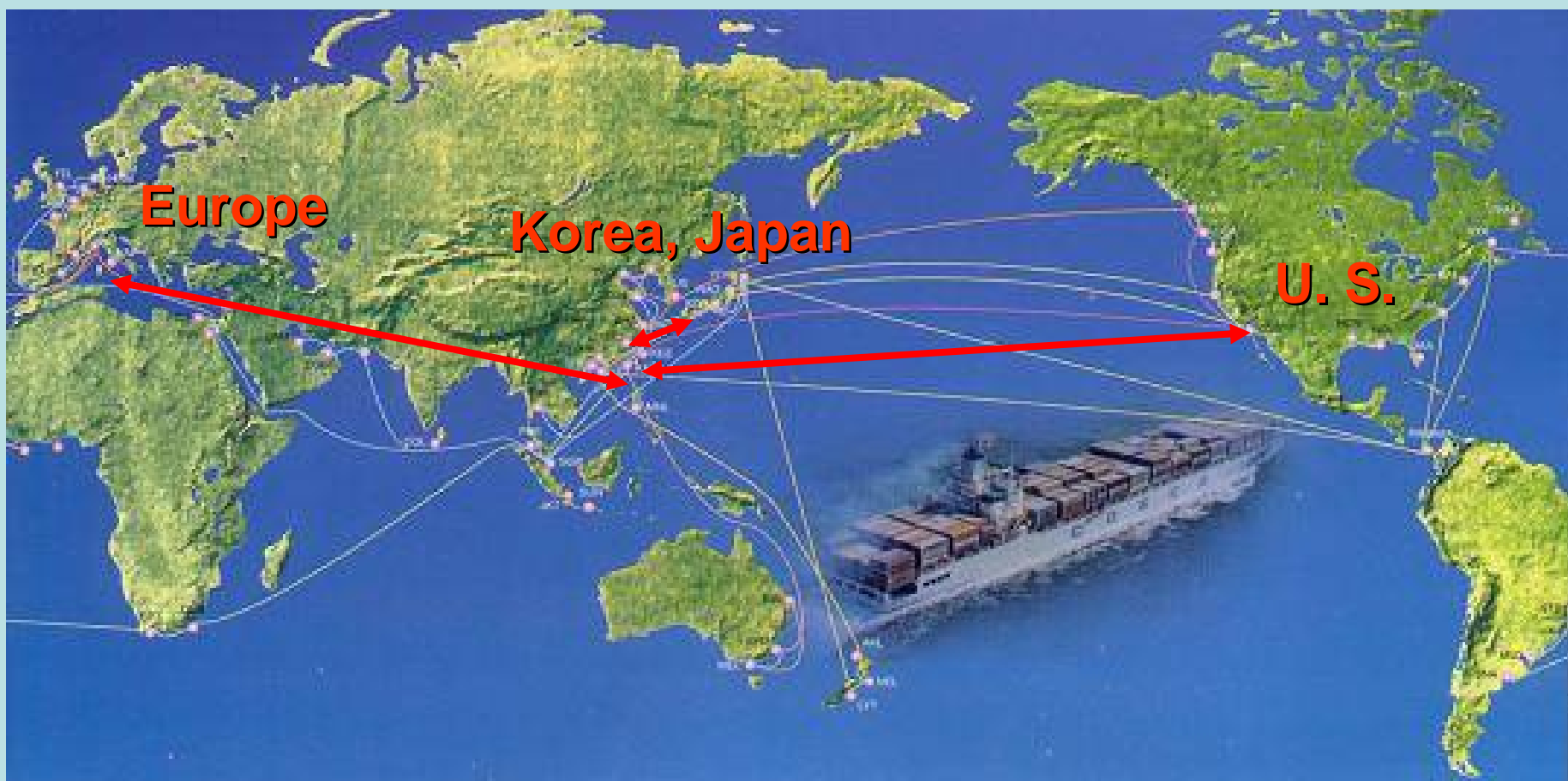

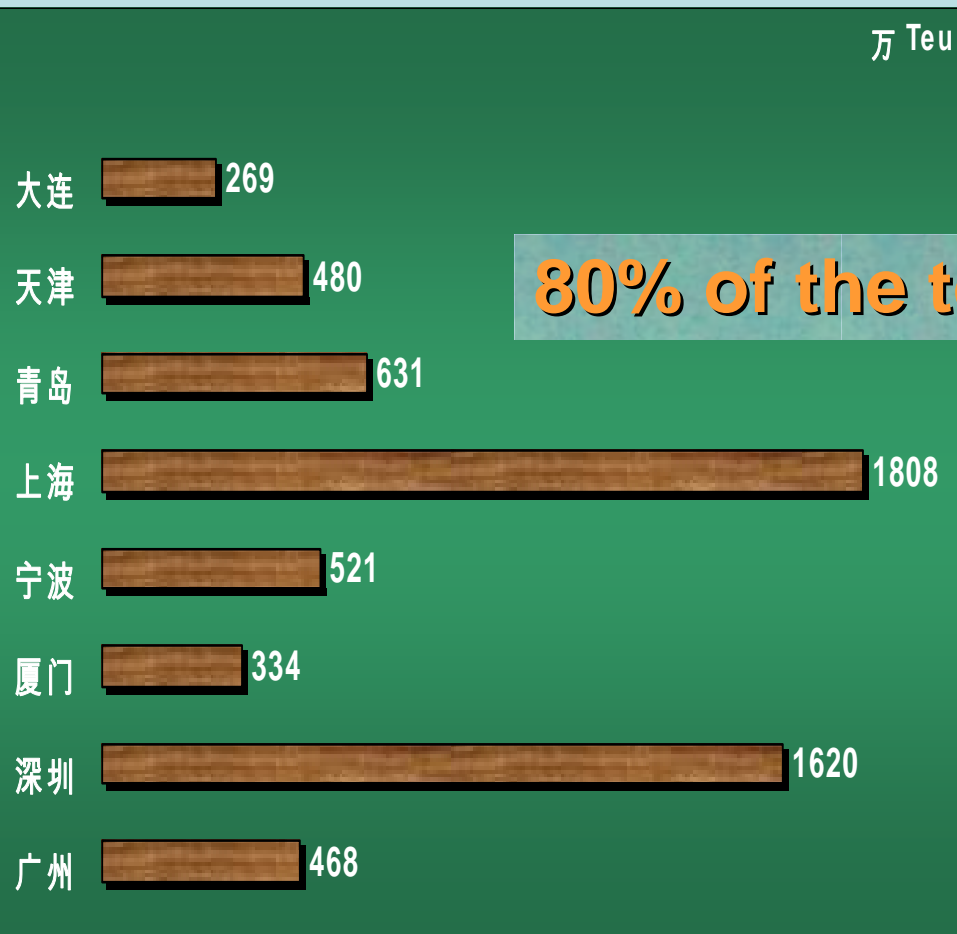

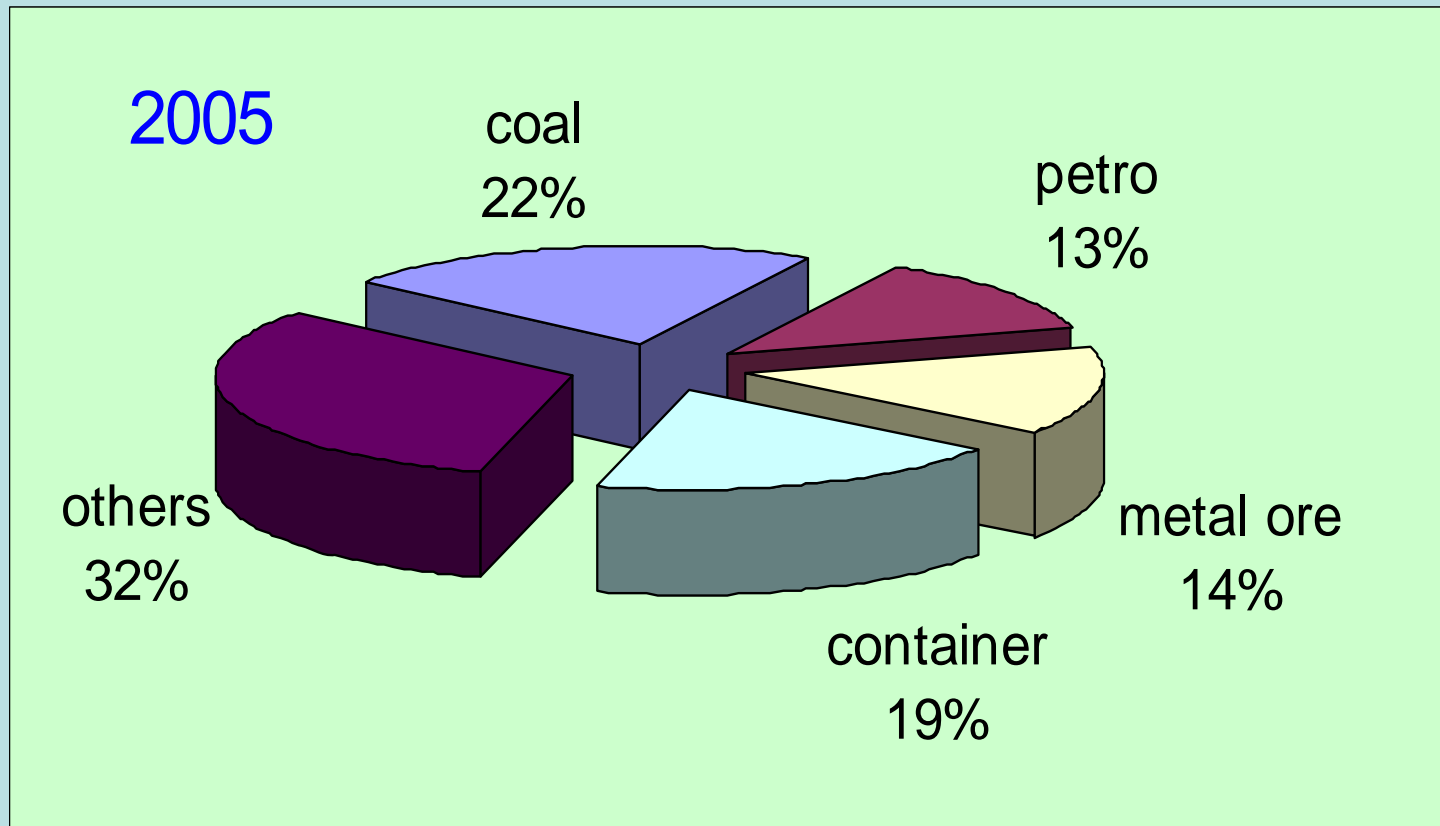

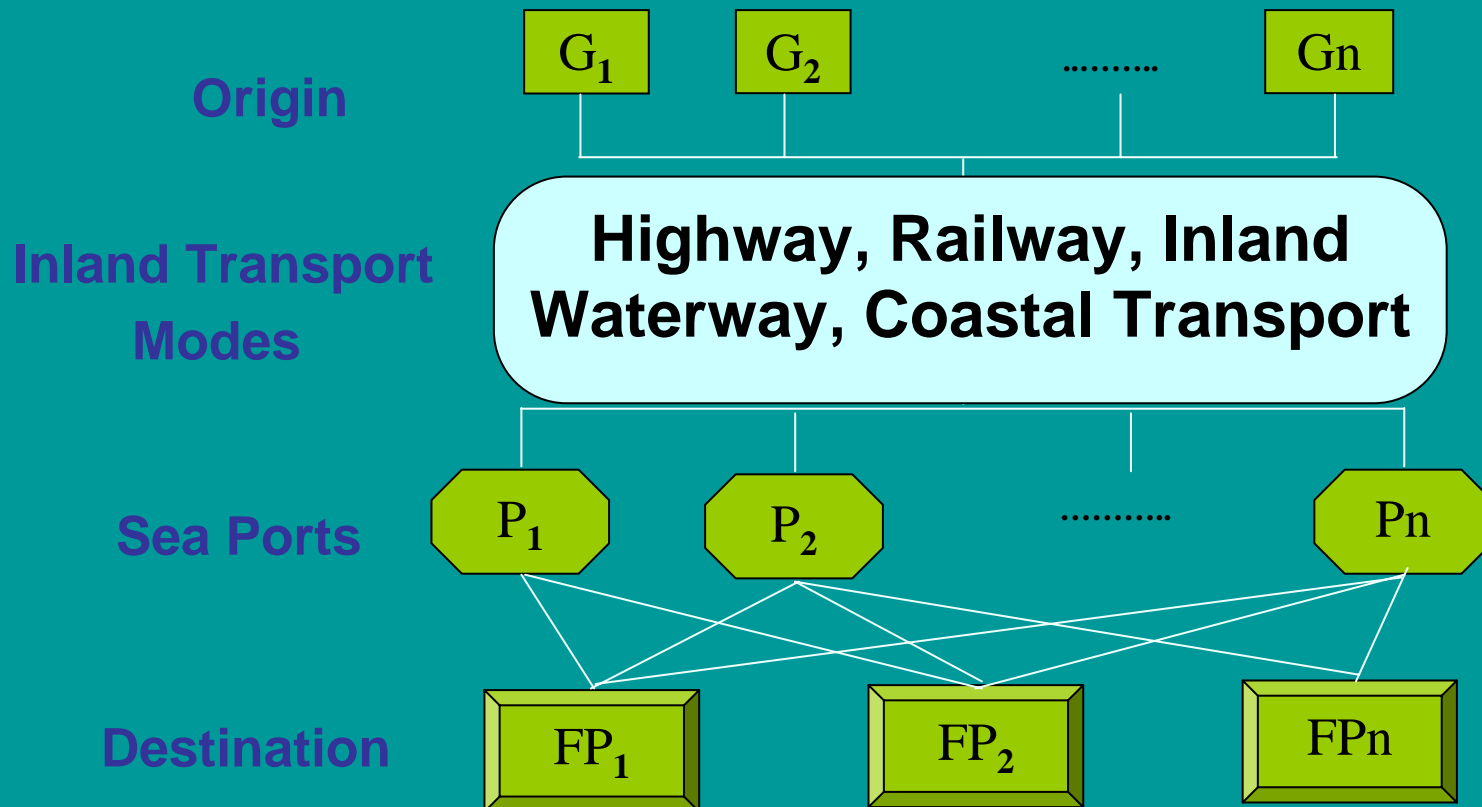

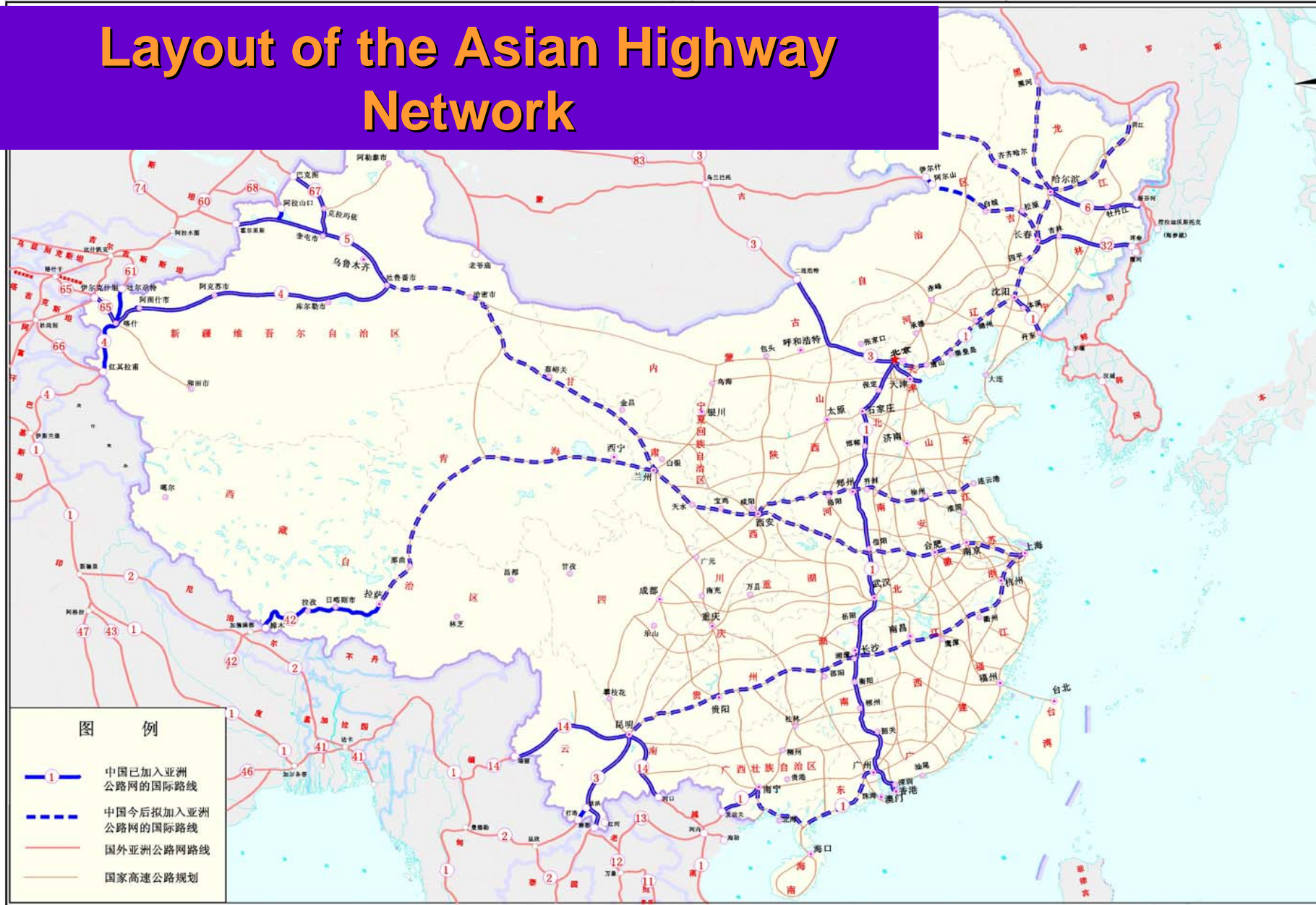

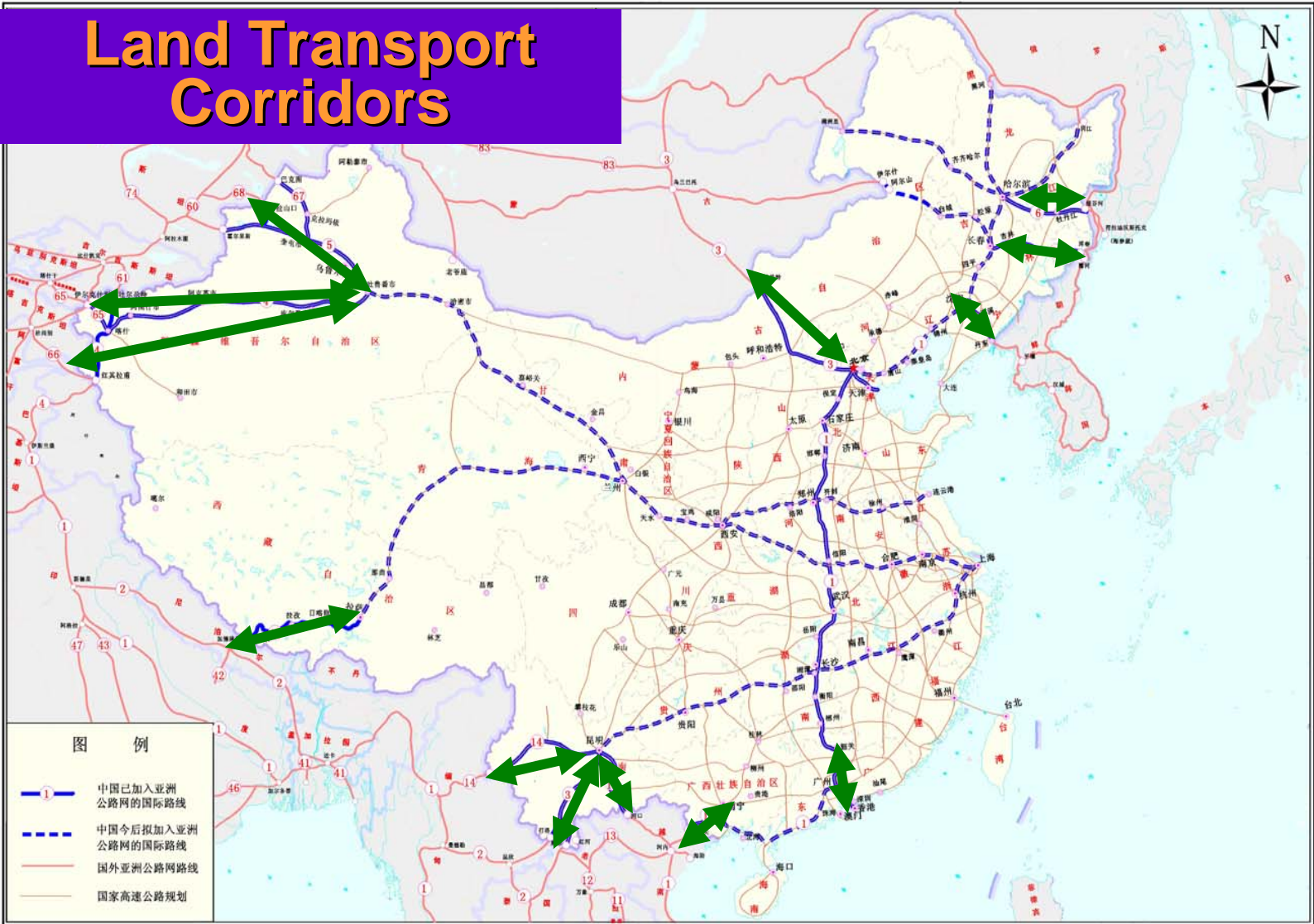

Traffic Volume of Land Transport Corridor

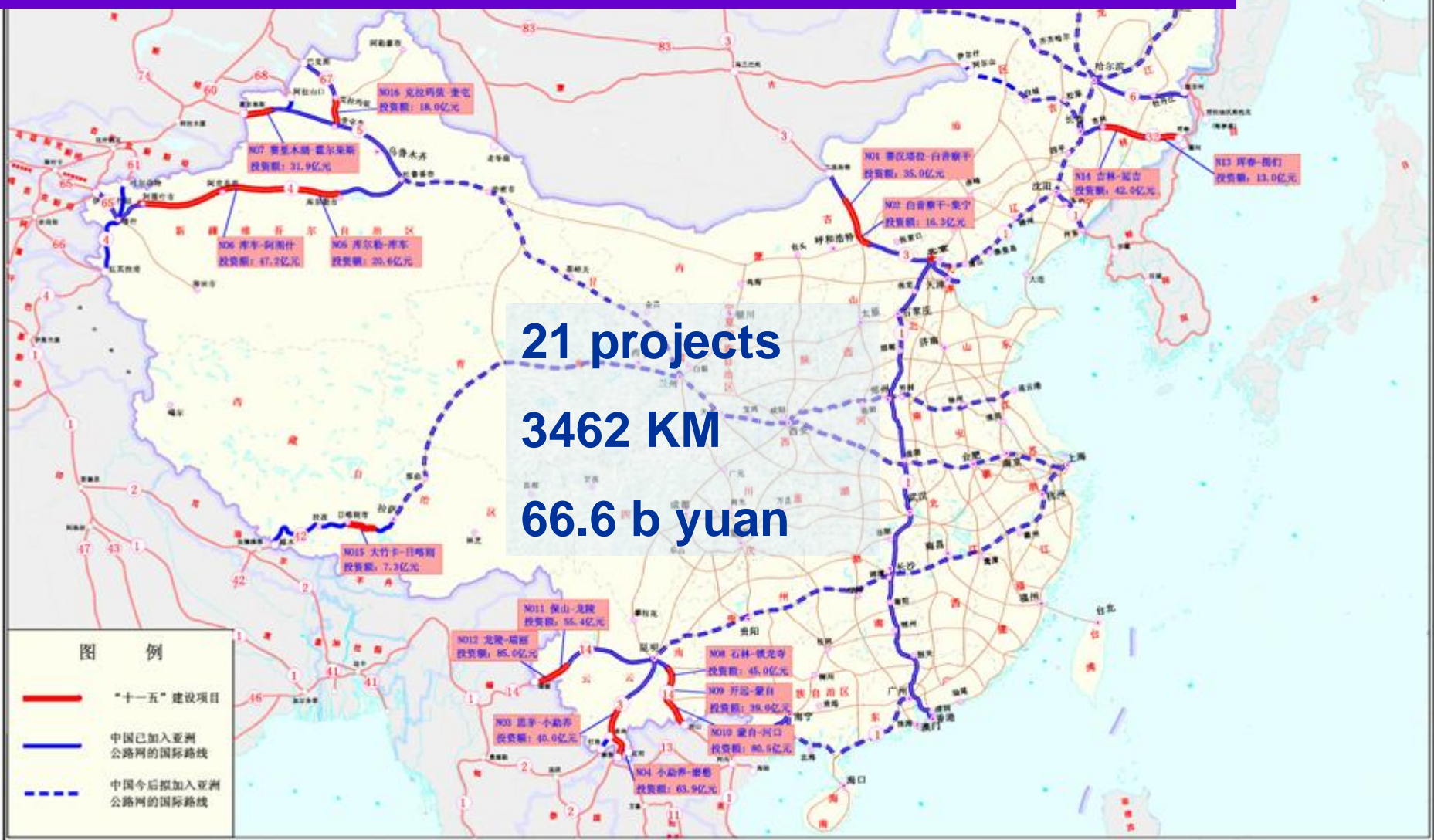
